Technical and manufacturing improvements over the years have improved quality standards resulting in a product which is now certified by the South African Bureau of Standards

In addition to buying only SABS approved tubing, it must be kept in mind that there are other factors which will affect the performance of this unique plumbing material.

Water quality may play a role - exceeding the recommended maximum speed flow of water may result in the removal of the patina layer and possible future pitting of the pipe inner surface. The chemical composition of the water may also have a negative effect on the copper but, as a rule, potable water should present no problem.

Even the best product will fail if poorly installed and it is important that the correct procedures are adhered to when installing copper tubing. If in doubt, employ the skills of a qualified plumber.

Adhering to the rules will ensure that your copper tubing will give you a lifetime of trouble-free water supply and protect you and your family, as copper Kills 99% of all known bacteria in the water supply.
